Case 1 From an un-even smile to a nice straighter smile

This patient here wanted to brighten and straighten her teeth and she did not want any extensive work such as crowns. Her smile was improved by providing her with Porcelain Veneers on 4 upper teeth and aesthetic composite build ups on lower teeth and some upper left teeth to give the patient a straighter brighter smile.





Case 2

From small teeth and unsightly smile to a nice and bright natural smile

This patient here wanted to improve his smile and only wanted work done on his front teeth.

His smile was improved by restoring his upper front teeth with six porcelain fised to metal crowns.

He was extremely happy with the results and later on wanted to get his back missing teeth replaced too.





Case 3 I hate that gap to wow I love my teeth

This patient here wanted the space closed between her upper central front teeth.

She did not want any exptensive treatments such as Veneers/crowns or even refused the Orthodontic treatment.

The space was close by simply using a tooth coloured filling materials and building up the two central teeth to close the gap.





Case 4

from a discloloured ugly prominent tooth to nicely blended white teeth

This patient had a history of child hood trauma on one of her front teeth. Internal bleaching was done for her after carrying out RCT on that tooth. Internal bleaching can be done for teeth that discolour over time following a trauma. A bleaching agent is placed inside the tooth over a period of 2 to 3 weeks and gives brilliant results.





<u>Case 5</u> <u>No preperation tooth coloured filling material to hide the yellow/brown tetracycline bands.</u>

This patient below had type 2 Tetracycline stains.

Teeth whitening was first attempted as she did not want any invasive treatments, but due to her non-compliance to the whitening trays and bleaching agent, the whitening treatment was abondoned.

It was decided to just provide her with a tooth coloured filling material on all her upper teeth without taking or grinding any tooth structure off.

A very white and opaque filling material (Composite) was used to provide her with these Componeers on all her uper teeth without any preperation of the teeth.





Case 6

I love my teeth. they don't look brown and ugly anymore. NO DRILLING!!!

This patient presented with flourosis and dis-colouration on all his teeth. Initial treatment planning involved micro-abrasion followed by teeth whitening and porcelain veneers if there is no improvement.

After two visits of micro-abrasion (which involves polishing the teeth with a paste made of coarse sand and a mild acid) under a rubber dam to protect the gums and lips, and a single visit of teeth whitening the following results could be seen.

Patient was very happy.





<u>Case 7</u> <u>From bulky veneers and a deviated smile to natural looking veneers and even smile</u>

This pleasant lady already had veneers which she got some ten years ago. She felt that they were too bulky and she felt that rightly so. She also did not like the way it made her smile look uneven.

The midline of her upper lip did not coincide with the midline of her teeth.

A new set of veneers were provided to her which were much thinner than her old ones and looked much more natural and her smile looked symmetrical not just to her but to us too.
